Citizens' Election Charter: A Vision for a Sovereign Nepal

Preamble:

As we approach the upcoming elections, we present this Citizens' Election Charter—not merely as a manifesto, but as a solemn address to the civic consciousness of every Nepali. We appeal to your wisdom to make a decision that will define our collective future.

1. Prosperity Through Unity:

True prosperity is impossible without national trust. Given Nepal's rich tapestry of ethnicities, languages, and religions, we require a "Development for All" governance mindset. We are committed to a federal democratic model that ensures no community is left behind.

2. Reforming the Federal Model

While we are the foremost advocates for federalism, we believe the model adopted in the 2072 Constitution has failed to meet the nation's aspirations—a fact proven by the last decade of experience.

- **Our Commitment:** To establish a powerful State Restructuring Commission and implement a federal model based on its expert recommendations.

3. Leadership: A Directly Elected Executive

In a diverse society like ours, power should not be confined to a singular figure elected behind closed doors.

- **Our Proposal:** A Cluster-based Presidency to ensure representation.
- **Executive Reform:** We advocate for a Directly Elected Prime Minister and Chief Ministers who can appoint cabinets consisting of both parliamentary members and outside experts to ensure
